Title of the thesis:	Financial Stability Transparency and Interest Rates

OVERALL ASSESSMENT (provided in English, Czech, or Slovak):

This thesis focuses on examining whether central bank transparency has an effect on the level of interest rates. It is an empirical project, which uses two types of transparency indexes – one for monetary policy and the other one for financial stability. It regresses the interest rates on transparency indexes controlling for some standard measures of economic conditions. It is estimated as panel. The regression mimick the well-known Taylor rules, to a certain extent.

Overall, I really like the thesis. It is well-written. It cites appropriate literature. Econometric model is inspired by the previous literature (CEPR DP by Geraats et al.) but approaches it differently given that the thesis employs a richer dataset that the CEPR DP. The model is executed correctly. But let me stress that there is, to the extent of my knowledge, only one article examining the link between transparency and interest rates (the above mentioned CEPR DP) so there is a clear value added in focusing on this topic. There are extensive robustness checks.

The thesis examines the determinants of both short-term and long-term interest rates and it finds that transparency sometimes indeed decreases the rates.

In my opinion, this is how empirical theses should look like and I fully recommend the grade A.
