

Abstract

The protection of landscape in the law

The thesis analyzes the legal protection of landscape and describes basic legal institutes of the international, European and Czech law which protect landscape. The thesis is divided into four chapters. The introductory chapter defines the term landscape and its scientific and legal meaning and presents the most serious problems of landscape in the present. Chapter Two characterizes the substantive law on the international level and is concerned with an analysis of international treaties. Chapter Three investigates the legal regulation of the protection of landscape in the European Union. Chapter Four provides an outline of the relevant Czech legislation, especially The Act No 183/2006 Coll. Building Act and The Act No. 114/1992 Coll. on Protection of Nature and the Landscape.
