

Abstract

The present paper aims to provide a focus for understanding issues of influences of the U.S. and Chinese policy regarding nuclear program of North Korea, between 2003 and 2014. Leverages of some selected foreign politics are analysed through the main political means towards the North Korean Nuclear Program. In this purpose, the U.S. and China's statements, negotiations, sanctions and relations with South Korea are thus particularly highlighted. This thesis does consist of three main parts. The first section deals with the influence of specified political means applied by the U.S., the second one looks at the influence of specified political means used by China, the final part analyses the collective influence of both U.S. and China's politics through multilateral negotiations within the Six party talks and sanctions imposed by United Nations Security Council. The main goal of this study is to evaluate and discuss about efficiency of U.S. and China's politics towards the North Korean Nuclear Program on defined period.
