### **OVERALL ASSESSMENT** (provided in English, Czech, or Slovak):

Ondřej in his thesis decided to investigate Czech labour market using data from the Internet. From the beginning we wanted to do something new and use the specific features of the Czech Republic and position of search engines. Ondřej worked on his thesis independently and with enthusiasm. That resulted also in quite unexpected data source provided by Jobs.cz and also possibility to visit their premises. Ondra thus received very unique data set from the supply side of the labour market, which makes the thesis even more interesting. Ondřej also used questionnarie to get better backround for the main data-gathering process.

The structure of the thesis is appropriate – litreture review providing background of the topic, methology and data gathering process, results and discussion. Research question is clearly stated in the beginning, examined and commented at the end. The content is of high quality level, yet especially in chapters 2 and 3 the text could be better reorganized making it easier for the reader to follow author's thoughs.

Methodology is properly used, models are tested. Used methodology exceeds what is taught at bachelor student in the level of econometrics. The only minor comment from my side is the presentation of ARIMA model. ARIMA model is described in the methodology, but results of only AR(1) model are presented – this might be confusing for reader.

For the above reasons, I suggest grade A
