

Abstract:

This thesis is focused on how much are the adolescent people who belong to Vietnamese minority integrated in region Ústí. I have chosen this region because I wanted to define one place to be more exact, and also because this region is interesting for its high number of unemployed people and the people belonging to the Roma minority. That was the reason which made my task more interesting because I wanted to see how these factors affected the integration of another minority.
