

The paper deals with comparison of trajectories of the post-war history revision in Czechoslovakia and Israel where the comparison with the Czech case should serve as a referential framework for introducing the disputes in Israeli historiography into the Czech environment. After the theoretical introduction, the second part analyses the development in Israeli historiography using a generation model and mainly the “new historiography” and the discussion that this group provoked. The following comparative part compares the debate on the post-war “resettlement” of Germans with the debate on the causes of the birth of the Palestinian refugee problem.
