

Abstract

The present thesis is called the community property of the spouses regulating property relations between spouses. It is divided into seven chapters, the first chapter is an introduction and the last conclusion.

It discusses the historical development of the law, since the Roman law to the current legislation.

Another chapter is devoted to defining the concept of community property of the spouses, its origin and content, including its use and administration. The following describes the modification of community property of the spouses and is worked out in detail his demise and settlement.

The fourth chapter is devoted to legislation enshrined in the New Civil Code, which becomes effective on January 1, 2014.

Finally, it describes the bond of community property of the spouses to private international law and a comparison of the arrangements of community property of the spouses in selected European countries.
