

ABSTRACT

This thesis deals with the topic that is related to drugs. This problem is quite broad content, it can accommodate several respects. The author chose a certain part, namely the crime of unauthorized production and other handling of narcotic and psychotropic substances and poisons under § 283 of the Criminal Code, in the context of the current situation. The theme of the drugs problem was processed in many dissertations, but it should be noted, has continued to discover new knowledge and to change trends in the drug scene.

The work consists of seven separate chapters. The first chapter introduces the reader to the issue, which is related to drugs and also defines the basic concepts relating to drugs and drug-related crime. This chapter is important for understanding the following chapters. The second part of the introductory chapter describes the division of drugs and about each group is given basic information.

The second chapter provides a history of the legislation related to drugs from Austro-Hungary until the present. The author dealt with national legislation and put the emphasis on the adjustment the facts of the case of unauthorized production and other handling of narcotic and psychotropic substances and poisons under § 283 of the Act no. 40/2009 Coll ..

Analysis of the current situation in the Czech Republic and in Europe is described in the third chapter. The author tried to point out the current situation and trends that most affect drug-related crime. The documents Monitoring Centre for Drugs and addiction and the European Monitoring Centre for Drugs and Drug Addiction have been used as the main source in this thesis. The author based mainly on their current annual reports and from various viewpoints on specific issues. The final part of this chapter contains a brief description of the antidrug policy of the Czech Republic, including a description of future plans and brief historical survey since 1993.

The fourth through sixth chapters deal with the central theme – an offence of unauthorized production and other handling of narcotic and psychotropic substances and poisons under § 283 of the Penal Code.

First, the author analyzes the facts of the case from the point of view of the obligatory characters - object, objective side, subject, subjective aspect and the individual qualified facts.

Two fundamental problems the current legal practice are presented in the fifth chapter. First, the ones are relatively describe in detail and then in the next chapter, the author speculates on possible solutions. Author largely drew a lot of reces of knowledge from special literature and the decisions of the Supreme and the Constitutional Court.

I firmly believe that this work will be beneficial for the readers to obtain information on drugs and crime associated with them.
