- 5. Bibliography (numbered, like the following chapter) should be considered before the Attachment, which should be without pagination.
- 6. Pagination starts from Introduction.
- 7. Minor errors in typography, graphics, transposition of photos and English will be mentioned in defending.

- 1. The author could specify his personal experience in music making at traditional weddings in Cyprus.
- 2. Using blogs as a relevant source for a bachelor thesis?
