Analytical comparison of narrative techniques in literature and film.

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ABSTRACT:

The goal of this thesis is the comparison of narrative techniques in literature and cinematography,

specifically in the book Isabelle by Tessa de Loo and in the homonymous movie by Ben

Sombogaart, and the consequent comparison of these techniques considering their final influence on

the presentation of both of these works. Techniques based on structuralist literary and movie

analysis were used in this thesis. The specific influences of the differences in narrative techniques

on the overall presentation of the work were discovered by comparing the results of the analysis.

cinematographic treatment of the particular work is.
