The airn of this diplorna thesis is to analyze the Common European Framework of Reference for Languages: Learning, Teaching, Assessment (CEF) and its important by-product, the European Language Portfolio (ELP). Also the current situation of foreign language teaching in the Czech Republic after the release of the abovernentioned documents will be dealt with.

The scope ofthis thesis will be focused rnainly of German as a foreign language and its position arnong other foreign languages taught in the Czech Republic. An analysis of chosen German language textbooks used in current language education is included. The analysis is focused on the textbooks' fulfilling the criteria of current European language policy.

The explorative study included in this thesis focuses on the language teachers' awareness of the issue of CEF and ELP and their opinions on advantages and disadvantages ofthe two documents concerned. Using the outcome of the study, we try to articulate our own suggestions on improving the CEF.
