Abstract:

The thesis addresses subject of innovative projects of NGOs in the field of parental support to return to the labour market after maternity leave.

The main purpose of the thesis is to deliver a report about the role of the NGO in the process of implementation of innovative projects by using case studies. The objective of the thesis is to identify outcomes and level of innovation of these projects on the basis of testimonies of active participants.
