

## **Summary**

The thesis deals with temporal effects of decisions of the Constitutional Court, by which a statute is repealed due to its unconstitutionality. Since the relevant provisions are not sufficiently comprehensive, various problems and doubts arise in legal reality. The thesis summarizes the relevant theoretical premises, which should allow for finding answers to questions related to the topic of the thesis. The relevant case-law is also summarized and subjected to partial criticism. The paper also deals with specifics of criminal law and civil law, including horizontal effect. It also specifically addresses the issue of concrete constitutional review and the phenomenon of so-called resurrection of law when a derogational statute is derogated.
