Contribution

This is an interesting and topical issue address in this paper. It uses linear probability and diffirence-indifferences models to analyze the increased educational requirement on nurse salary and employment in the Czech Republic. The results suggest that there is negative effect on nurse's salaries with respect to doctors. However, there is no significant negative effect on employment of nurse compared to doctors. The study contributes to the policy evaluation literature by using appropriate methodologies to analyze the impact of 2004 policy changes in Czech Republic.

Methods

One of the most applied policy evaluation method in the literature is Difference-in-Differences and in this particular topic estimation method fits to the study. Both methods, linear probability and difference-in-differences, seems appropriate for examining the effects of 2004 reforms on nurse salaries and employment in Czech Republic.

Literature

Literature review seems to me very short and only few studies are presented in this section. In my opinion, it would be better to present additional stuties in the literature review for providing deeper understanding of where your research fits in the literature.

Manuscript form

The form of the thesis looks appropriate, however, I would like to mention few things. First, it would be good to have results presented in the introduction part of the thesis. Preferably, before starting to explain the structure of the thesis. Secondly, literature review part needs to be improved in my opinion as I mentioned the reason above.
