Contribution

The thesis examines the impact of macroeconomic news announcements and ECB communication on the value and volatility of 5 European stock indices, particularly German DAX, Portugal PSI-20, Greece ATHEX, Italian FTSE MIB and Spain IBEX 35. The main contribution of this paper is the mutual comparison of indices' reaction on ECB communication. Student shows different reaction patterns in DAX and indices of PIGS countries. Paper demonstrates that ECB communication has bigger impact on the volatility of DAX index comparing to indices of PIGS countries.

Veronika nicely presents the overall results in the Tables 4 and 5. When it comes to ECB communication, Veronika had to read several ECB statements and speeches of Mario Draghi in order to figure out the impact of the communication on the intended monetary policy. Please, see the appendix.

Methods

The thesis is standard empirical exercise applied on GARCH-type models. Student examines different models from GARCH family and tests both normal and Student's error distribution. I would like to emphasis that this kind of model is not the subject of bachelor study and student has to study it by herself. Author demonstrates very good understanding of the model concept and its empirical application.

Literature

The thesis contains relevant literature survey. Author provides wide knowledge of literature realted to GARCH model and the impact of central banks' communication and news announcements on financial markets in Chapter 2 – Literature review. She also uses nice citations in the text. For example, results are compared with existing literature.

Manuscript form

The thesis is logically structured and the literature is well cited. Manuscript is neat, written in Latex editor. However, I can see some drawbacks. For example, the equations are sometimes numbered, sometimes not. Thesis has some typos.

Let me acknowledge, that Veronika worked systematically on her bachelor thesis and regularly consulted her writing progress.
