

Abstract

Diploma thesis deals with the life of journalist Rostislav Korčák. During the World War II led Korčák lived two different lives when he worked as a loyal editor of Venkov journal, but he also published an illegal journal the Czech Courier, one of the most important Czechoslovak resistance journal during the World War II. Because of his illegal activities, he was imprisoned and persecuted by Gestapo and then subsequently transported to the concentration camps of Terezin and Mauthausen. After World War II, he entered the Communist Party of Czechoslovakia and became a member of Zemědělské noviny. He died at the age of 90 in 1984.
