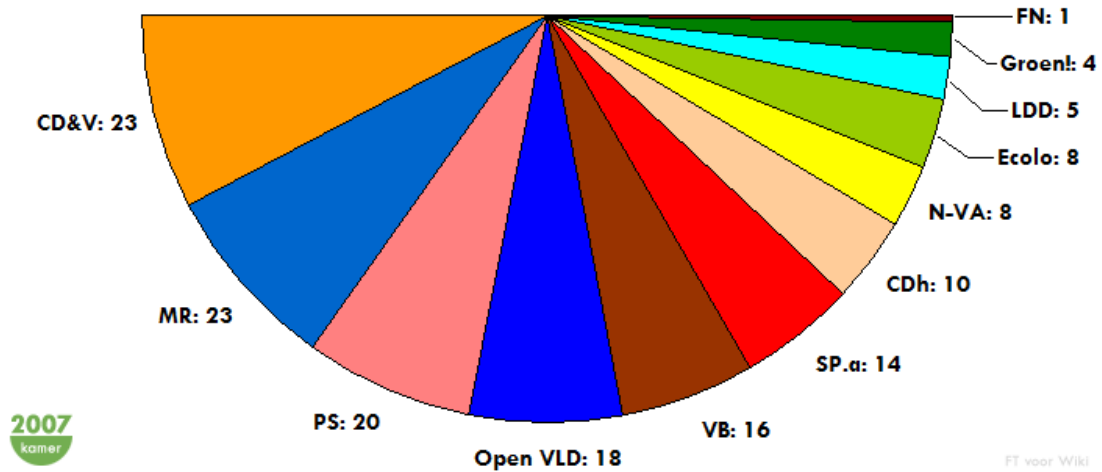

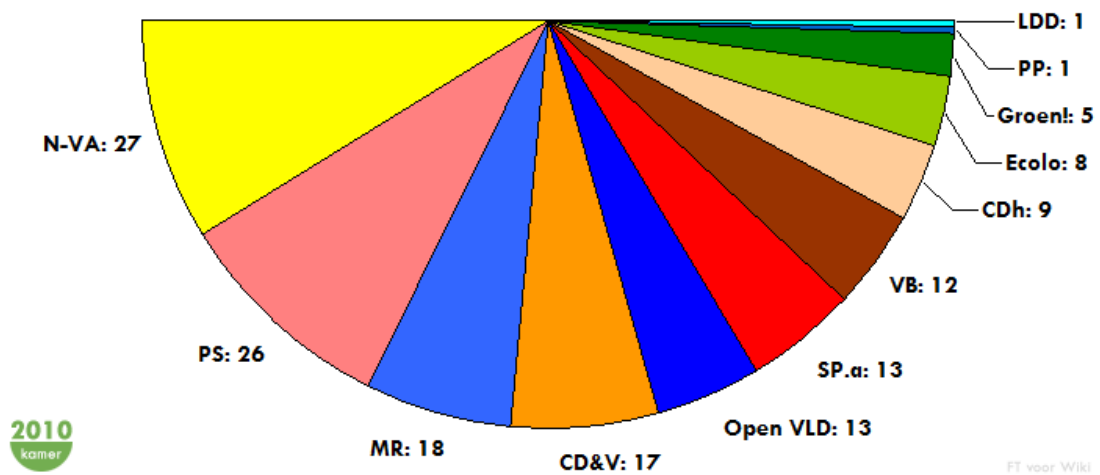

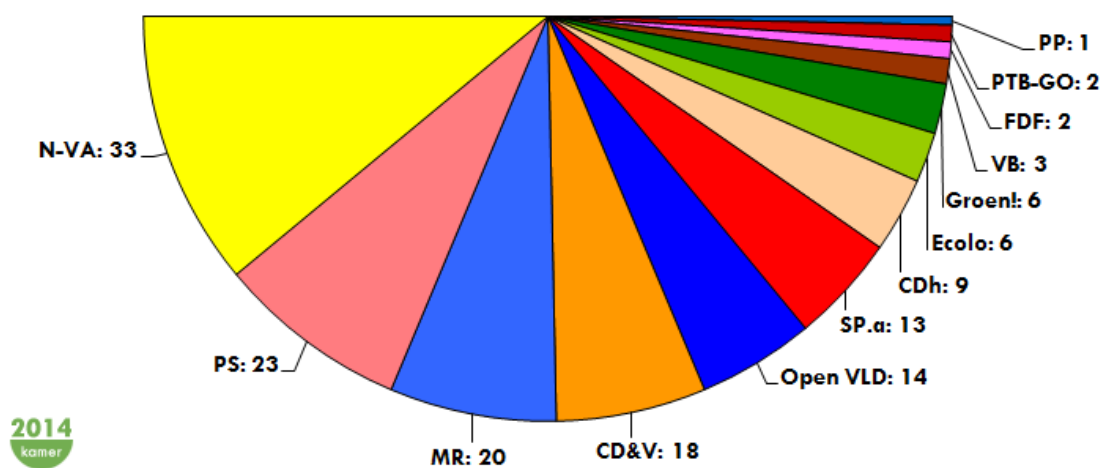
Příloha č. 1: Rozložení Sněmovny reprezentantů 2007 (graf)

Hello Tereza,

In attachment you can find our program for the (European) elections in 2009 - unfortunately it's only available in Dutch. In 2007 and 2010 there were no elections for the European Parliament.

I would like to underline that the N-VA is a pro-Europe party, and not a Eurosceptic party.

The N-VA wants a stronger Flanders in a stronger Europe. After all, more and more challenges are arising in this globalised world that we must deal with at a supranational level. The macro level for us is the European Union. Competences that require a supranational approach must therefore be transferred to the European level (i.e. currency, defence, migration, internal market, energy, etc.). Competences that must be exercised closer to the people must be transferred to Flanders, which is the appropriate micro level for the N-VA.

The N-VA is convinced that Flanders must acquire its own voice in the European Union, at the same level as other countries and states, some of which are even smaller than Flanders. But, even as an autonomous state, we will still be linked to and stand in solidarity with other states, within the European Union first of all.

The N-VA is above all a Eurorealistic party. We are not afraid to question how the EU works. Not because we have any doubts about its utility and importance but because the EU should not be taken for granted. The European Union can only have enough support if it manages to make the right choices – and dares to do so. That is one of the reasons why the N-VA is a member of the ECR Group in the European Parliament. The N-VA is also a member of the European Free Alliance (EFA).

May I first of all refer you to our website – in English: <https://english.n-va.be/>. There is a heading with FAQ and the basic party manifesto is also available under these headings.

Nevertheless I summed up the essential pillars of the N-VA policies and politics.

#### **ABOUT N-VA:**

The N-VA, New-Flemish Alliance, is a relatively young political party that promotes a modern, forward-looking, inclusive and democratic form of Flemish nationalism. The N-VA defends the political, social, economic and cultural interests of the 6.5 million people in Flanders by developing sound policies, taking parliamentary initiatives, carrying out in-depth research, taking actions tailored to the media, and carrying out political campaigns.

The party has a broad electoral appeal. In the last election, one in three Flemish voters voted for N-VA. 2014 was to say an election victory. The N-VA currently is the biggest party in both the Federal Chamber of Representatives, with 33 members on a total of 150 representatives, and the Flemish Parliament, with 43 representatives on a total of

124. The N-VA is represented by four ministers and two state of secretaries at the federal level and by three ministers in the Flemish Government, led by minister-president Geert Bourgeois.

**BELGIUM, FLANDERS: WHAT DOES THE N-VA SUGGESTS** Belgium is the sum of two democracies. A country where two nations, the Flemings and the French speakers, have different key opinions towards societal problems and challenges. Where different and shifting policy opinions and actions are being taken.

The N-VA strives for more autonomy for Flanders. We want to turn the Belgian federation into a confederation of autonomous regions. In a confederal model the regions are responsible and owner of their competences. The regions can decide to exercise and implement their powers, or decide together to cooperate on the confederal level for specific competences.

The shift towards full confederalism is an evolution, not a revolution. It is a gradual development where increasingly more competences are transferred to Flanders, as the political center of gravity.

The fundamental principle in that perspective is that democratic governance should be as close as possible to its citizens. In short, the N-VA strongly advocates a renewed respect for the fundamental principle of subsidiarity. There are either two essential policy levels (center of gravity). Flanders: the appropriate micro level within a confederal state; European level: for competences that require a supranational approach.

#### WHAT ARE THE CORE VALUES:

Socio – economic responsibility & stimulating entrepreneurship Working, or entrepreneurship should not be voted down but instead have to be supported and rewarding for both employee and employer. The government should develop a stable, legal certain and predictable framework that stimulates and is committed to individuals and companies but does not lock down the dynamics of the free market.

The free market principles as a fundament for an innovation based growth It is to say that the N-VA strongly believes in the merits of the free – market economy, based on the principles of a level playing field for all actors in the market and an equilibrium between individual and collective rationality. Intervention and mediation over the government in a direct or indirect way with regard to price formation should be avoided at all times.

A social security that is social and secure. Solidarity must be organized in a transparent, efficient and effective manner. It should not become a hammock to speak, but should rather function as a safety net and as a trampoline: offering a springboard to an active participation in the socio economic society.
