

The Graduation paper is directed at the validation of touch capabilities of visually impaired children of the age 13–17 years, through application of STIP test. STIP, developed in United Kingdom, is transformed into doted Braille code and verifies the speed of reading the numbers. Accuracy vs. error rate in the lines, speed of reading and concentration (attention) will be assessed. On the basis of the test evaluation aligned with relevant manual, the performance of children is compared with the UK children in the same age category. Following the comparison, the overall evaluation of this research is performed.
