Abstract:

Theme of this bachelor thesis is Horror Cinematography in the Republic of Korea. The goal of the thesis is the description of the korean horror movie history and investigation of the most often repetitive supernatural elements and the reasons of their presence in horror cinematography.

The first part of the thesis focuses on the general overview of the horror genre.
