Abstract:

The bachelor thesis deals with the Dynamic Assessment of Young Children by Tzuriel. Tzuriel has developed several dynamic tests for younger children. The tests will be individually presented in the text. The main aim of the work is to present research studies carried out by Tzuriel and his colleagues using these diagnostic tools. A number of these studies have demonstrated the importance of intervention, mediation and educational programs to develop the cognitive skills of individuals.
