

## **ABSTRACT**

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In the Czech Republic, there is currently no fully complete and functional electronic database of medicinal products intended for animals. Until 2014, veterinary medicinal products were part of the AISLP V database published by SÚKL in Praha. However, this practise ended with release of version 2014.3, following version of AISLP V database no longer contains veterinary products. Certain hope for those interested in veterinary informations has become database named VetInfo, which has been conceived by Cetli s.r.o. since the end for previous form. But the creation of this database is not yet complete, so there are only working and officially not distributed versions for now. A regular part of undergraduate education at our faculty is a subject focused on the issue of veterinary drugs with pharmacological effects; The above-mentioned AISLP V database was, in addition to other resources, repeatedly used for the detailed processing of veterinary issues in the form of diploma theses of the students and the updating of the lessons. This diploma thesis continues similarly focused theses and uses the two above-mentioned databases to analyze current situation.
